ABOUT THE EVENT

The "Train the Trainers" event was a key milestone in the Digi Helicon project. Its purpose was to equip selected trainers with the necessary skills and knowledge to carry out two critical project activities:

National Workshops in Partner Countries

Trainers will be responsible for leading national workshops in their respective countries. These workshops aim to engage local artists, providing them with tools to thrive in a digital environment.

Facilitating the Digi Helicon Online Course

Participants received an in-depth introduction to the Digi Helicon online course. This course is designed to help artists leverage digital tools and trends to enhance their art promotion strategies and organizational skills.

Additionally, attendees had the chance to preview the prototype of the Virtual Exhibition, an innovative feature that will allow artists to showcase their work in an open, pan-European exhibition.

WHAT IS NEXT

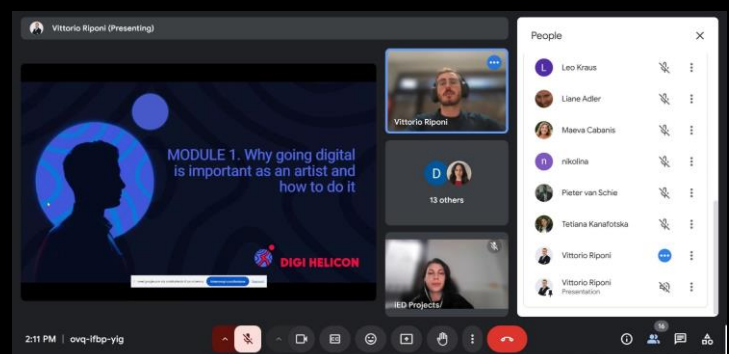
